


Please check tapestry on a regular basis as there are a few pieces of information shared weekly including information about your child's homework.



EYFS



This week we have begun our new topic of space. We concentrated on our world and learned the terms earth, globe, North Pole, South Pole and equator. We made a model of the earth with some children painting the oceans and others adding land, poles and labels



We have also used the book Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. Linked to this story we have painted penguins using different tools and wrote our own versions of the story. We Laos used lots of different instruments to make loud noises like the ship in the book and quiet noises like the boy.

KS1

This week we have been locating the UK on a world map and locating the four countries that make up the UK on a map of the UK. In Art we explored with clay. We use the tools and water to see how we could manipulate the clay into different things. We have continued to develop our balancing and coordination skills in PE this week. We also included the element of team work to help with our co-ordination.


IN THE SPOTLIGHT
